# Scottish Government Policy Context

Over £1 billion of public funding has already been invested to transform Scotland's rural, remote and island communities in terms of digital connectivity

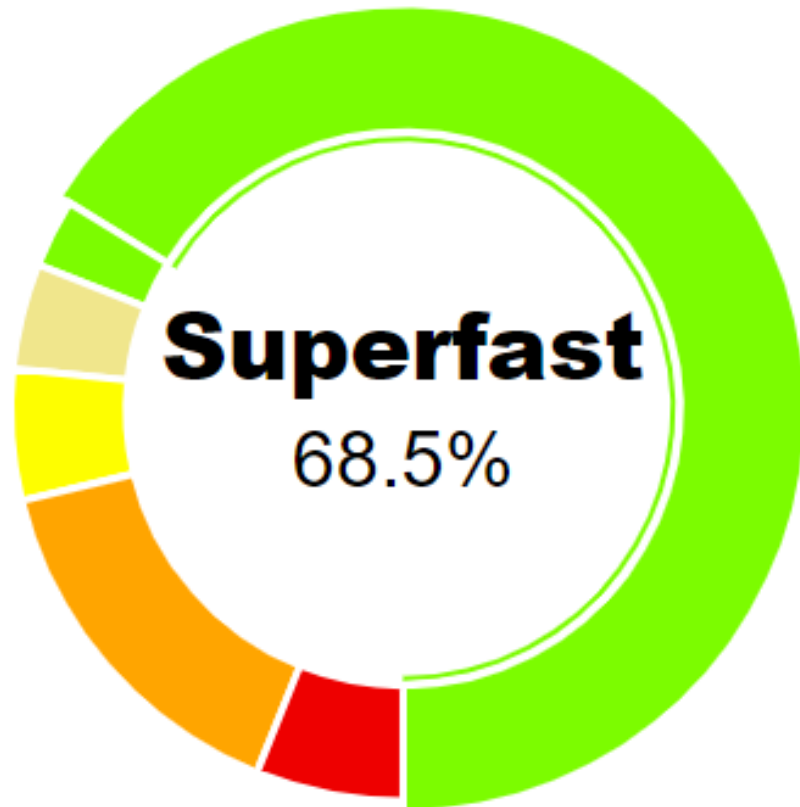
Scotland has received £28.5 million to date of UK Government Project Gigabit

We want to ensure that Scotland receives its fair share of Project Gigabit funding and that there is a flexibility of approach given the more challenging nature of Scotland's geography and topography

Our 10-year National Strategy for Economic Transformation (NSET) sets out the ambition to provide an efficient and resilient digital infrastructure, including continued investment in improved broadband and fibre

The principle of 'No One Left Behind' is central to Scottish Government's joint Digital Strategy with COSLA – which sets out our commitment to build a Scotland where geography, background or ability is not a barrier to getting online and benefiting from digital technology and the need to maximise gigabit investment in Scotland

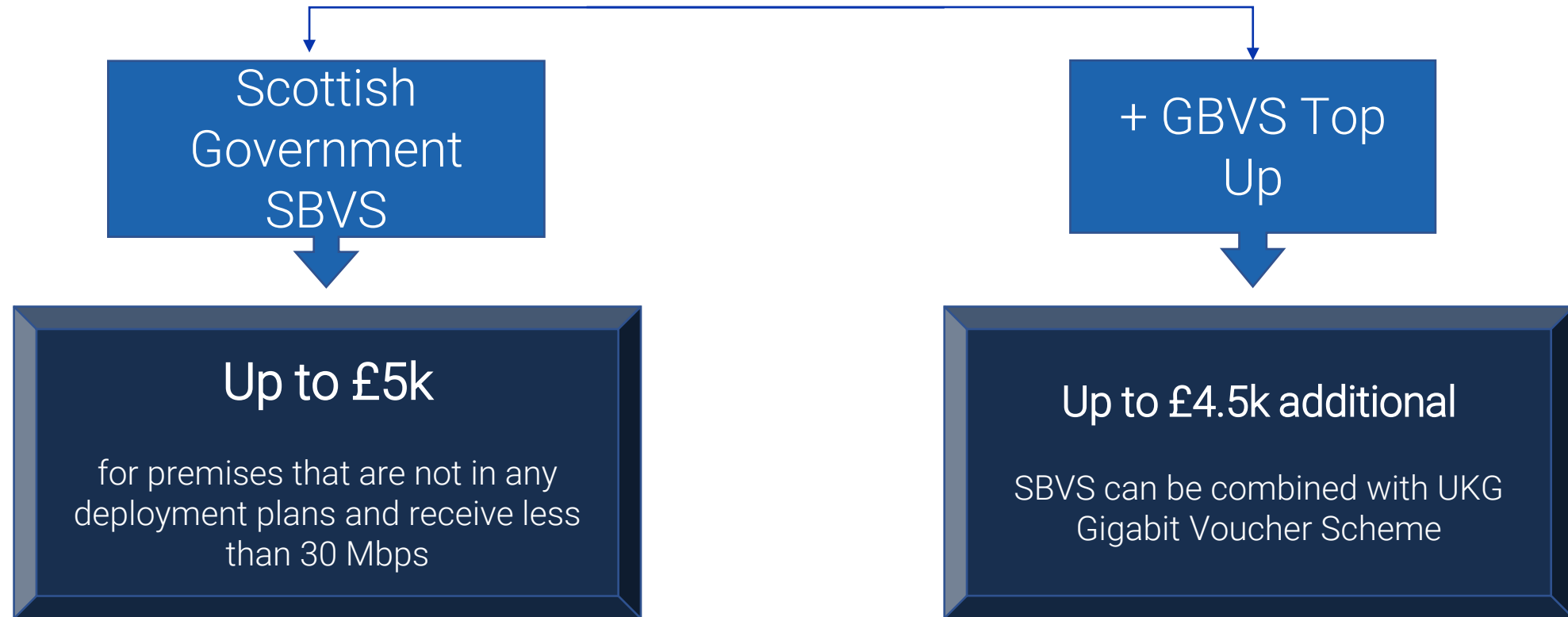
## Revised Deployment Plan

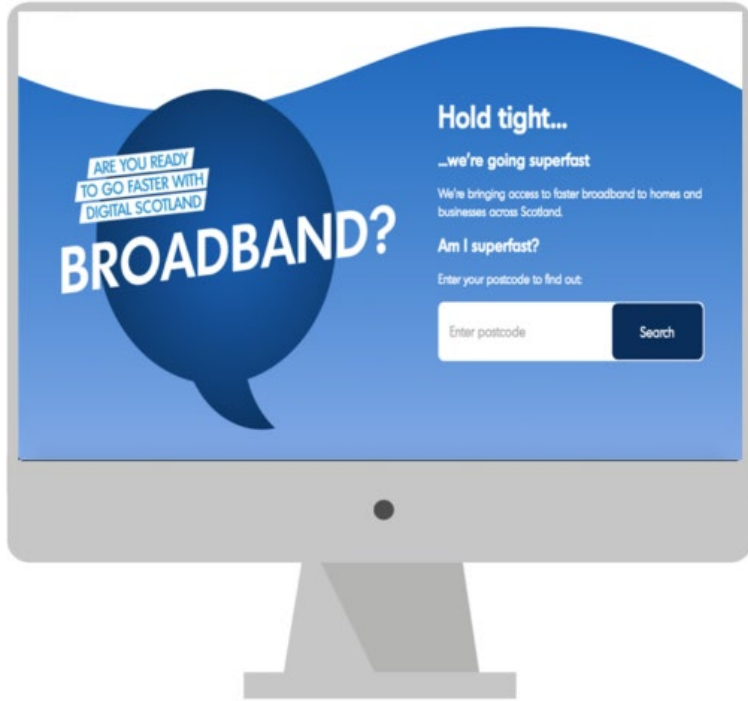

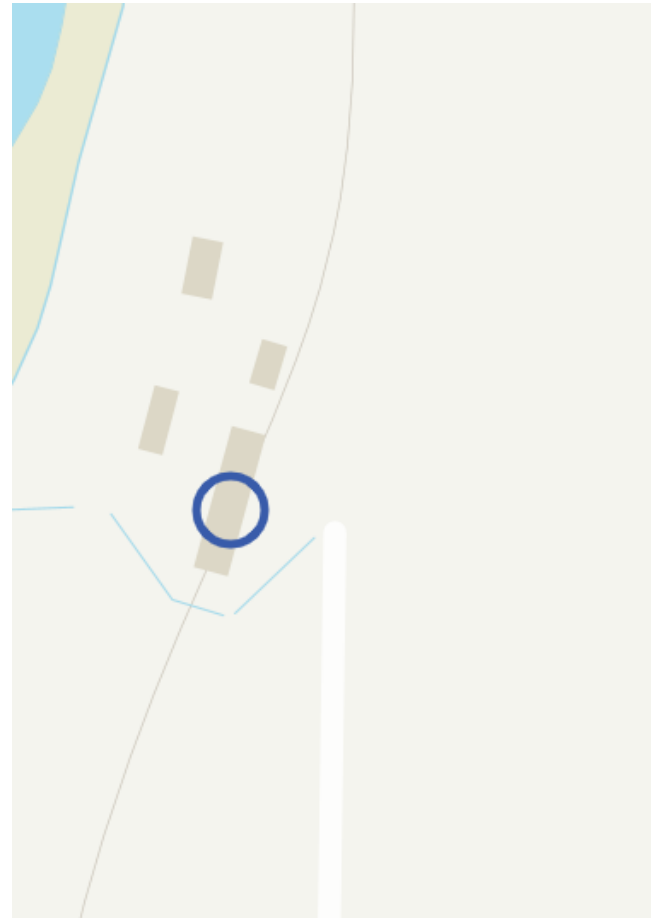

## Furrow End, Balfour, Orkney

A new superfast connection is being built in your area. It's part of the Scottish Government's Reaching 100% (R100) superfast broadband programme.

Based on the current engineering schedule your address is in scope to receive its superfast connection by the end of September 2024.

The new connection will mean your address can get faster internet speeds. That'll make it easier to video call loved ones, watch shows online, work from home and more.

What's coming?

All of the planned R100 build in the South and North, and the vast majority in Central, will be gigabit capable – this is more than 30 times faster than the original Scottish



# R100 Website: Voucher Guidance

## Apply to SBVS

To apply for the R100 Scottish Broadband Voucher Scheme you need to liaise with one of our registered suppliers. Here's how to do it (desktop users click to expand images):

**FINDING A SUPPLIER**  
A supplier applies for a voucher on your behalf.  
The voucher – which is funded by the Scottish Government – works by providing your supplier with up to £5,000 to connect your property to superfast broadband.  
When you find a supplier who can provide you with a service, they claim the funding from the Scottish Government on your behalf.

## When a supplier contacts you

If a registered supplier contacts you about using your voucher to supply you with a broadband service, here's what to do (desktop users click to expand images):

**YOUR CONTRACT**  
You'll enter into a commercial contract with your supplier, as is normal when buying a broadband service. We're not party to this contract, but we do ensure that the most they can charge for a minimum 12-month superfast broadband contract is £48.90 per month.  
Suppliers may also offer you packages that cost more and provide faster speeds, but this decision is yours.

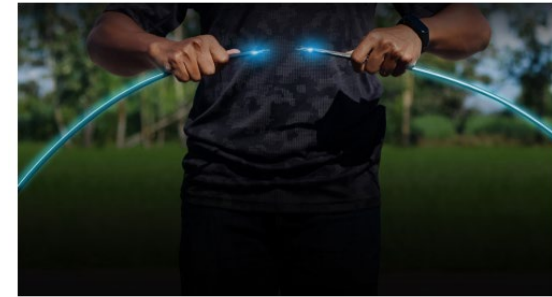


## R100 Scottish Broadband Voucher Scheme continues to make a difference across Scotland

# Island Build Logistics

Infrastructure build on the islands presents a number of challenges, including:

- Transportation of plant and materials to the islands
- Identifying suitable site compounds for the safe storage of plant and materials during work
- Identifying suitable work areas close to rolling build programme for plant and materials
- Maximising use of local sub-contractors/workforce
- Seeking accommodation for workforce
  - Looking at providing a floating accommodation unit which then needs safe berth and suitable landing points
- Maximising build at each location

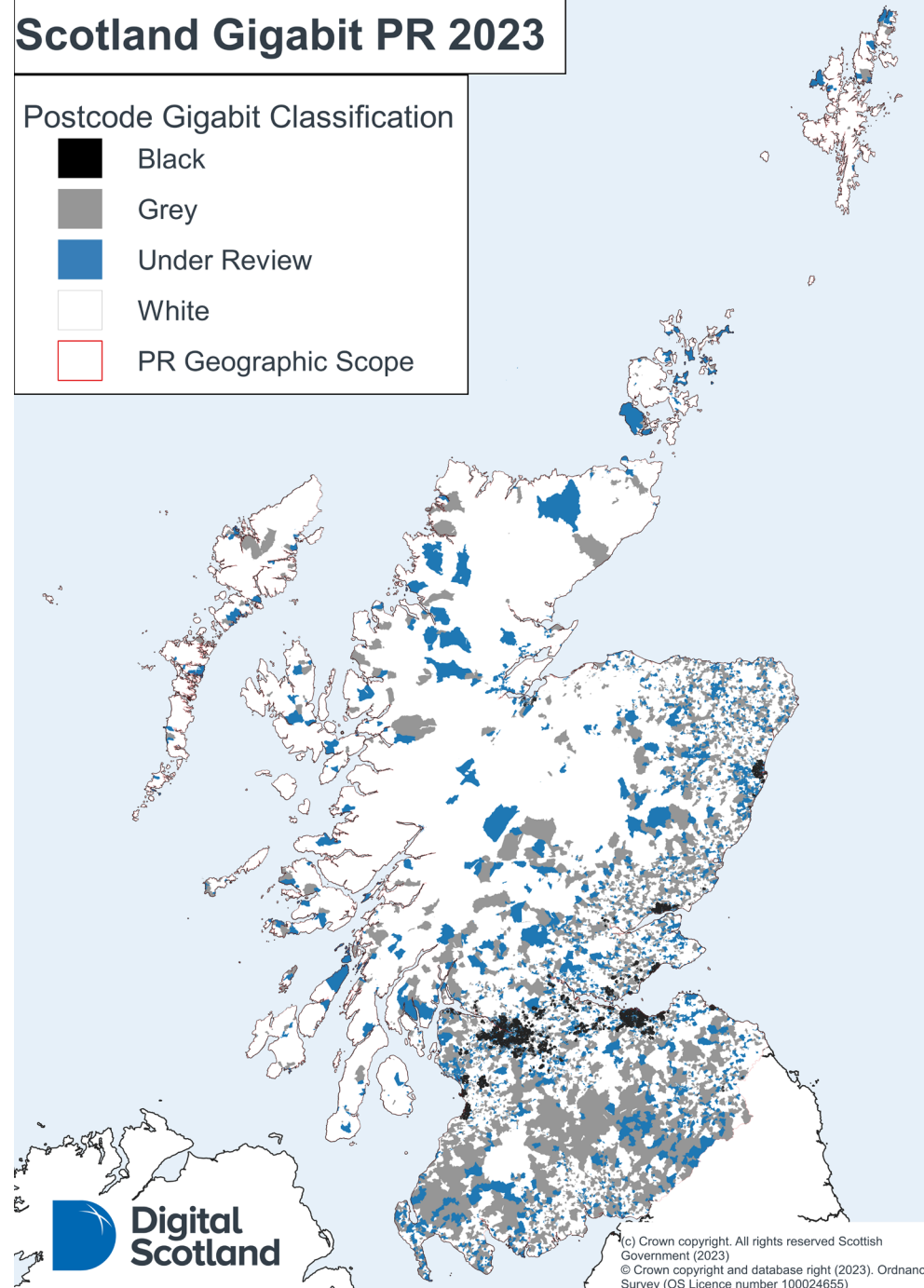
